- Valid Certificate of Qualification issued by the BC Ministry of Labour or the approved equivalent, for the particular trade in which the incumbent is employed
- Valid BC driver's license of the appropriate class required to carry out related trade functions
- Ability to read and interpret related technical information and maintain an up-to-date knowledge of the trade.
- Must have working knowledge of WCB regulations, Motor Vehicle regulations as they relate to the trade.
- Must hold and maintain WHMIS certification and Level I First Aid Certificate as supplied by the Employer.
- Preferably completion of a registered apprenticeship in the respective trade, or training and work experience equivalent to the full apprenticeship contract terms established for the particular trade.

**Specialized Abilities & Skills**

- Aptitude and capability in the performance of specific trade functions
- Ability to work in conjunction with other employees and assist apprentices in learning and developing the skills of the trade, and/or to periodically direct the efforts of another employee assigned to assist them



- Physically and mentally compatible with the work involved and able to work under the rigors of the job.

- Must have personal supply of trade related tools.
