Position Accountabilities

Aggregates:

- Quality control testing of materials being crushed.
- Stockpile material testing.
- Report results to a Senior Asphalt Inspector with final testing data for entry into the computer.

Asphalt:

- Perform quality control testing on all asphalt - moisture, temperature, A/C, grading and densities.
- Take samples from a truck at plant take to lab and process.
- Plant moistures.
- Follow proper testing procedures according to asphalt being produced (e.g. A.T. specs).

- Ensuring proper personal protective equipment is worn when necessary.
- Conduct testing of all asphalt materials (bin samples, midstream samples).
- Relaying all information to the Senior Asphalt Inspector.
- Maintain a consistent inventory of lab equipment.
- Provide support when asphalt coring.
- Maintain a consistent inventory of lab equipment.
- Keep lab and equipment clean and usable.
- Assist in training part-time employees.

Communication:

Scale Person

- Monitor the amount of tonnage being produced.
- Monitor the type of outgoing tonnage to the road.

Tower Man

- Provide moistures.
- Request mid- streams.
- Monitor temperature change in asphalt.
- Monitor A/C changes.


Customer Service:

- Project a professional image in dealing with the public, internal and external clients, suppliers, and subcontractors.
- Model a clear understanding of who the internal and external customers of the Volker Stevin Group of Companies are.
