- Responsible for the EMC in-field classroom and hands-on training at Highway Maintenance Yards including
 greasing, maintenance of all Fleet Services equipment, load securement, pre-post trip inspections, heavy
 truck & trailer brake adjustments, wheel torques, operations and calibration of sanding systems and
 manufacturer operational procedures of equipment.
- Deliver training for "New Equipment" focused on changes including all operational and manufacturer specified changes and or new features on new equipment.
- Manage snowplow simulator training.
